

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Alford Road and Wellin Lane, Edwalton)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (8271)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads at Edwalton in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along : -

ALFORD ROAD, EDWALTON

(north-east side) From the centre line of its junction with Wellin Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 18 metres

(south-west side) From its junction with Wellin Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres

LYTHAM DRIVE, EDWALTON

(north-east side) From its junction with Wellin Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres

(south-west side) From its junction with Wellin Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres

WELLIN LANE, EDWALTON (north side)

From a point 12 metres north-east of its junction with Alford Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 16 metres south-west of that junction

WELLIN LANE, EDWALTON (south side)

From a point 20 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with Lytham Drive in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 77 metres

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting Mon to Fri 8am – 4.30 pm along :

WELLIN LANE, EDWALTON (north side)

From a point 16 metres south-west of its junction with Alford Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres

3. Other restrictions : **Bus Stop Clearway** – No Stopping, except Buses At Any time

ALFORD ROAD, EDWALTON

(north-east side) - outside properties 127, 129 for a distance of 19 metres

(south-west side) – outside properties 82, 84, 86 for a distance of 19 metres
