

Consultation Notice Proposed Street Tree Felling Section 96a Highways Act 1980

Consultation reference: Radcliffe Road, West Bridgford

NOTICE is hereby given that Nottinghamshire County Council, as the Highways Authority proposes to fell four street trees, which are situated at the following locations: -

- Mabel Grove at its junction with Radcliffe Road
- Cyril Road link footway at its junction with Radcliffe Road (South Side)
- Opposite Cyril Road link footway at its junction with Radcliffe Road (North Side)

The felling is necessary to deliver improved cycling and footway provisions, and there are no appropriate other methods available in this instance. Four replacement trees will be placed in the local vicinity.

If you wish to respond to this consultation, or find out further information, you can do so by writing or emailing the undersigned quoting the reference shown, no later than **Friday 5th December**.

Responses must state if you are against or in favour of the proposed felling, as well as reasoning to support your response. Please ensure to include your full name and either your home address or email address in order for us to make you aware of our decision following the consultation.

A decision response to this consultation will be published no later than 28 days before the tree is felled.

The results of this consultation will remain applicable for a period of 2 years.
