

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Norman Avenue and Station Road, Sutton-in-Ashfield) (Prohibition of Waiting and Residents' Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4220)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Sutton-in-Ashfield in the District of Ashfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along the following: -

NORMAN AVENUE (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (the north-east side)

• from its junction with Station Road in a south-easterly direction for 30 metres

NORMAN AVENUE (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (the south-west side)

• from its junction with Station Road in a south-easterly direction for 59 metres

STATION ROAD (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (the north-east side)

• from a point 53 metres south-east of its junction with Lawn Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 212 metres to a point 45 metres north-west of its junction with Bathwood Drive

STATION ROAD (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (the south-west side)

- from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with Lawn View House access road in a north-westerly direction for 148 metres
- from its junction with Heathcote Place in a south-easterly direction for 30 metres
- from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Norman Avenue in a south-easterly direction to a point 17 metres south-east of that junction
- 2. Residents' parking bay operational Monday to Friday between the hours of 9am and 5pm along the following:-

STATION ROAD (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD) (the north-east side)

- from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with Lawn Avenue in a south-easterly direction for 38 metres
- 3. Bus Stop Clearway no stopping, except buses, at any time at the following location:-

STATION ROAD (SUTTON-IN-ASHFIELD)

• Bus stop AS0062 – introduce 19 metre bus stop clearway
