

The Nottinghamshire County Council
(Alfreton Road and Beech Road, Underwood)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (4224)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Underwood in the District of Ashfield:-

Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following lengths of roads: -

ALFRETON ROAD, UNDERWOOD (the north-west side)

- from a point 16 metres north-east of its junction with Beech Road in a south-westerly direction to a point 16 metres south-west of that junction

BEECH ROAD, UNDERWOOD (both sides)

- from its junction with Alfreton Road in a north-westerly direction for 20 metres
