**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, LADYBROOK ESTATE, MANSFIELD)**  
**(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (2207)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to roads in in the District of Mansfield:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the following length of road,
  - (i) **Armstrong Road**, from its junction with Ladybrook Lane in a north-westerly direction to its most north-western extremity.
  - (ii) **Birks Road**, from its junction with Armstrong Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Brick Kiln Lane
  - (iii) **Caunton Close**, from its junction with Kirkland Avenue in a south-westerly direction to its most south-western extremity
  - (iv) **Cherry Grove**, from its junction with Brick Kiln Lane in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Ward Place
  - (v) **Danvers Drive**, from its most south-western extremity in a north-easterly direction to its most north-eastern extremity.
  - (vi) **Frith Grove**, from its junction with Armstrong Road in south-westerly direction to its most south-western extremity.
  - (vii) **Halam Close**, from its junction with Armstrong Road in north-easterly direction to its most north-eastern extremity
  - (viii) **Kirkland Avenue**, from its junction with A38 Sutton Road in a north-westerly direction to its junction Jenford Street.
  - (ix) **Howard Road**, from its junction with Westfield Lane in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Broomhill Lane
  - (x) **Harrison Road** from its junction with Ward Place in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Ladybrook Lane
  - (xi) **Jenford Street**, from its junction with Kirkland Avenue in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Ward Place.
  - (xii) **Jenkins Avenue**, from its junction with Armstrong Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Somersall Street.
  - (xiii) **The Knoll**, from its south-eastern junction with Jenford Street in a south-westerly, then north westerly, then north-easterly direction to its north-western junction with Jenford Street.
  - (xiv) **Markham Place**, from its junction with Armstrong Road in south-westerly direction to its most south-western extremity.
  - (xv) **Marlborough Road**, from its junction with Broomhill Lane in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Chesterfield Road South.
  - (xvi) **Nelson Close**, from its junction with Danvers Drive in a south-easterly direction to its most south-eastern extremity.
  - (xvii) **Redlands Road**, from its junction with Somersall Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Danvers Drive
  - (xviii) **Somersall Street** from its junction Jenkins Avenue in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Westfield Lane
  - (xix) **Sylvester Street**, from its most south-west extremity in a north-easterly direction to its most north-east extremity.
  - (xx) **Ward Place**, from its junction with Cherry Grove in a north-easterly then westerly, then south-westerly direction to its junction with Harrison Road.
