

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS RDS, LADYBROOK ESTATE, MANSFIELD) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (2207)

Statement of Reasons

The County Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph speed limit to a number of roads in the Ladybrook Estate area of Mansfield.

The designated cycle routes are being designed to improve access to jobs, local shops, schools and other local services to help cater for increased demand for cycling facilities for local residents, and encourage more people to cycle more often. Encouraging more cycling is an important element in delivering national and local aims to address local congestion, air quality and health issues.

The speed limits are being introduced to improve safety for vulnerable road users and cyclists on designated cycle routes.

The new speed limit would be marked with new 20mph signs on the entry to the road and smaller repeater signs erected along the length of the road.
