**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD, BARNBY
MOOR AND TORWORTH) (40 M.P.H. & 50 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (1204)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to roads in Barnby Moor and Torworth in the District of Bassetlaw:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the following length of road,

A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD from a point 75 metres north of the centre line of the A634 Retford Road in a northerly direction to a point 270 metres north of the centre line of the A634 Retford Road.

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the following length of road,

A638 GREAT NORTH ROAD from a point 270 metres north of the centre line of A634 Retford Road in a northerly direction to a point 445 metres south of its junction with Daneshill Road.
