**ORDER 2019 (1228)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Dunham On Trent in the District of Bassetlaw:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the Following length of road

Main Street, Dunham On Trent

From a point 298 metres east of Green Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 631 metres
