(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) RESTRICTED ROAD ORDER 2019 (7208)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:-

1. The length of A60 Mansfield Road at Arnold and Redhill in the Borough of Gedling specified below shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

from a point 60 metres north of the centre point of the traffic island at its junction with Cross Street in a northerly direction to a point 390 metres north of its junction with Redhill Road.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref: 7208) must be received by me by the **8th day of March 2019**.

The 30mph speed limit is being introduced to replace the existing 40mph speed limit. The new speed limit would start at point 390 metres north of its junction with Redhill Road. The new position will ensure that all the built up area of Mansfield Road will be within a 30mph speed limit. The lower speed limit will help reduce the speed of traffic approaching the numerous junctions and driveways.
