**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (ACCESS TO LAY-BY OFF MANSFIELD
ROAD (A60), RAVENSHEAD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 2019 (7209)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:-

1. **To prohibit vehicles from driving into the lay-by on**

The south-west side of **A60 Mansfield Road** at Ravenshead in the Borough of Gedling

from a point at the back of the footway off Mansfield Road (A60) approximately 373 metres south of a point opposite the centre line of Gray's Drive in a south-westerly direction over the area of the existing lay-by.

Written objections (stating grounds and quoting ref: 7209) must be received by me by the **30th day of August 2019**.

The lay-by would be closed to all vehicles except those needing access to the fields and woodland off the back of the lay-by. The main reason for the proposed closure is to stop the lay-by being used for fly-tipping. Access into the lay-by is potentially dangerous as it is located on a busy bend.
