

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Tuxford Road (A6075), Boughton) (30 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Restricted Road Order 2019 (3296)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Boughton in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. The following length of road shall become a restricted road (with a speed limit of 30mph)
  - (i) **Tuxford Road (A6075)** – from a point 57 metres north-east of its junction with Main Road in a north-easterly and a south-easterly direction to a point 70 metres south-east of its junction with Church Road.

The new 30mph speed limit will replace a section of the current 40mph speed limit in Boughton. The 30mph speed limit is in keeping with other villages in Nottinghamshire and is the speed limit recommended by the Department of Transport. The lower speed limit is the most appropriate for a built up area.
