

**NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a “Toucan” pedestrian crossing on the A611 Hucknall Bypass in the District of Ashfield, approximately 25 metres north of its junction with Wood Lane.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area will be:

Hucknall Bypass

From a point approximately 1m north of the junction of the A611 Hucknall Bypass and Wood Lane for a distance of approximately 36m in a northerly direction.

The Toucan crossing will provide a safe crossing facility across the A611 Hucknall Bypass for pedestrians and cyclists.
