**SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019 (1230)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Cuckney in the District Of Bassetlaw:-

1. The following length of road shall be a restricted road (30mph) for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.:-

**Budby Road, Cuckney** – From a point 53 metres west of Sandy Lane in an easterly direction for 19metres

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the following length of road:-

**Budby Road, Cuckney** – From a point 32 metres west of Sandy Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

3. Any previous speed limit order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replace by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order are hereby revoked.
