NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an **Experimental Order** under the road traffic regulation act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads in Little Carlton in District of Newark and Sherwood: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on: -

A616 Ollerton Road, Little Carlton and South Muskham

From a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Ollerton Road (Western Arm) to a point 25 metres west of its roundabout junction with B6325 Great North Road
