**SHERWOOD WAY SOUTH (A617) AND HAMILTON ROAD, SUTTON IN ASHFIELD –
PROPOSED 40MPH SPEED LIMIT (TRO 4260) AND U TURN PROHIBITION (TRO 4261)**

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce a 40mph speed limit on Hamilton Road and a U turn prohibition on Sherwood Way South (A617). The proposals are being introduced as part of the Summit Park development.

The new 40mph speed limit is proposed to replace the existing national speed limit (60mph) between the junction with Sherwood Way South (A617) and the existing roundabout junction with Hamilton Way. The new limit would result in a 40mph speed limit from the A617 to the existing 30mph speed limit on Hermitage Lane. The proposed U turn prohibition would be on Sherwood Way South at the central refuge opposite the access into the Summit Park development. The prohibition will prevent vehicles, heading in a north-westerly direction, from making a U turn to gain access into the development and vehicles leaving the development from making a U turn to head in a north-westerly direction. These manoeuvres would be potentially very hazardous on the busy Sherwood Way South.

Due to the restrictions imposed by the coronavirus measures the consultation documents can not currently be deposited at the local library or County Hall as the regulations require us to do. The Government have relaxed this requirement and so a full set of consultation documents can instead be viewed on either the Nottinghamshire County Council website or they can be sent to you by post or e-mail on request.

Before proceeding further with the proposed speed limit and U turn prohibition, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter (address at bottom of letter) or email, by **3rd August 2020**.
