

## **PROVISION OF PUFFIN CROSSING ON B6045 BLYTH ROAD, WORKSOP**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a puffin crossing on B6045 Blyth Road, in the District of Bassetlaw approximately 12 metres north-east of its junction with The Baulk.

The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

### **B6045 Blyth Road, Worksop (the north-west side)**

- From the south-west kerb line of its junction with The Baulk in a north-easterly direction for 47 metres

### **B6045 Blyth Road, Worksop (the south-east side)**

- From a point 7 metres north-east of its junction with Blyth Grove in a north-easterly direction for 47 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians in crossing the road to access amenities such as Bassetlaw Hospital and North Notts College. Further details can be found by visiting the County Council's Website (<https://consult.nottinghamshire.gov.uk>)
