ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Alford Road, Edwalton in the Borough of Rushcliffe approximately 8 metres South of its junction with Valley Road.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are: -

Alford Road – east side

from a point 8 metres north of its eastern junction with Valley Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

Alford Road – west side

from a point 6 metres north of its western junction with Valley Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians crossing Alford Road.
