

PROVISION OF PUFFIN CROSSING ON MAIN STREET, LINBY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a Puffin Crossing on Main Street, Linby, where the current informal crossing point is located.

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

MAIN STREET, LINBY

(the north-east side)

- From a point 1 metre north-east of its junction with Quarry Lane in a south-westerly direction for 61 metres.

(the south-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 1 metre north-east of its junction with Quarry Lane in a south-westerly direction for 43 metres.

The crossing is being installed to make it safer for the school children and general public to cross the road especially at rush hour and peak school times during the day.
