

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B6045 BLYTH ROAD,
WORKSOP) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025
(1314)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council **Has Made** an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Worksop in the Bassetlaw District of Nottinghamshire: -

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time along the following lengths of road: -

B6045 BLYTH ROAD, WORKSOP (the south-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 56 metres northeast of its junction with Westfield Drive in a north-easterly direction for 24 metres.
- From a point 20 metres southwest of its junction with Highland Grove in a south-westerly direction for 30 metres.
