

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Epperstone Road, Nottingham Road, Oxton Road and Southwell Road, Oxton and Southwell. Sandy Lane, Oxton) (50 M.P.H. Speed Limit) Order 2017) (3265)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Oxton and Southwell in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

1. **Epperstone Road (B6386), Oxton**  
from its junction with Main Street in a south-easterly direction to its junction with the Oxton By-Pass (A6097).
2. **Nottingham Road (B6386), Oxton**  
from its roundabout junction with the Oxton By-Pass (A6097) in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Main Street.
3. **Oxton Road (B6386), Southwell**  
from its junction with Southwell Road in a generally north-easterly direction to a point 205 metres north-east of the centre line of its junction with Cooks Lane.
4. **Sandy Lane, Oxton**  
from its junction with Southwell Road (B6386) in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.
5. **Southwell Road (B6386), Oxton**  
from its junction with Epperstone Road in a generally north-easterly direction to its junction with Oxton Road.

The 50mph speed limit is being introduced to bring the speed limit in line with the existing speed limits on the B6386 (between the A614 and the A6097) and the A6097. The lower speed limit would help to reduce the number of accidents on the B6386 between Oxton and Southwell. The 50mph speed limit is also in keeping with the recommendations made as part of the A and B road speed limit review.
