

B6386 WESTGATE, SOUTHWELL – PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra crossing across B6386 Westgate, Southwell between Coghill Court and Hillside Drive in the District of Newark and Sherwood.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

B6386 WESTGATE, SOUTHWELL (both sides)

- From a point 13 metres west of the centre line of Coghill Court in a westerly direction for 42 metres

The crossing is being installed to help reduce traffic speeds and to assist pedestrians in crossing the road, especially school children.

Any objections should clearly state the reasons for the objections and should reach us in writing, either by letter or email, by **15th October 2026**. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
