

The Nottinghamshire County Council (B6463 Styrrup Road Oldcotes) (Restricted Road and 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 (1243)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Oldcotes in the District of Bassetlaw:-

1. The following length of road shall be a restricted road (30mph):-

B6463 Styrrup Road

From its junction with A634 Blyth Road in a northerly direction for 181m.

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road:-

B6463 Styrrup Road

From a point 181 metres north of its junction with A634 Blyth Road in a north-easterly direction to a point 280 metres north and then north-east of the same junction.

The speed limit would be consistent with the existing 30mph speed limit on Blyth Road. The new speed limit would mean that all the built up parts of Oldcotes are in a 30mph speed limit. The proposed reduction in speed limit will help improve road safety for pedestrians and road users.
