## <u>B6463 STYRRUP ROAD, OLDCOTES – PROPOSED 30MPH SPEED LIMIT (TRO 1243)</u> <u>– PUBLIC ADVERT</u>

Via East Midlands, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce a 30mph speed limit on B6463 Styrrup Road, Oldcotes. The speed limit would start at the junction with A634 Blyth Road and extend in a northerly direction for a distance of 280 metres. The new 30mph speed limit would replace the existing National Speed Limit (60mph). The speed limit would be consistent with the existing 30mph speed limit on Blyth Road. The new speed limit would mean that all the built up parts of Oldcotes are in a 30mph speed limit.

The proposals will be advertised in the Nottingham Post on 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2020 with notices displayed on site. A plan showing the extents of the proposed speed limit is attached (Drawing Number H/JAB/3226/01) along with a copy of the site notice.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
