

PROVISION OF TOUCAN CROSSING ON BECKSIDE, EDWALTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a toucan crossing on Becksid, Edwalton in the Borough of Rushcliffe near the existing refuge south-west of Rosthwaite Close.

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

BECKSIDE, EDWALTON (the north-west side)

- From a point 22 metres south-west of its junction with Rosthwaite Close in a south-westerly direction for 45 metres.

BECKSIDE, EDWALTON (the south-east side)

- From a point opposite a point 22 metres south-west of its junction with Rosthwaite Close in a south-westerly direction for 45 metres.

The crossing is being installed to improve pedestrian safety across the road and provide a crossing point for cyclists travelling along the adjacent cycle routes. Further details can be found by visiting the County Council's website (<https://consult.nottinghamshire.gov.uk>)
