

**PROVISION OF PUFFIN CROSSING WITH RAISED PLATEAU ON BERRY HILL LANE,
MANSFIELD**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a raised puffin crossing and Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a raised traffic calming plateau on Berry Hill Lane, Mansfield, immediately west of Black Scotch Lane in the District of Mansfield: -

1. The proposals will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where **parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited**. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

BERRY HILL LANE, MANSFIELD

(the north-east side)

- From a point 12 metres north-east of its junction with Jenny Becketts Lane in a south-westerly direction for 62 metres.

(the south-east side)

- From a point 7 metres north-east of its junction with Black Scotch Lane in a south-westerly direction for 62 metres.

2. The crossing will be constructed on a 75mm high raised traffic calming plateau, the effects of which will be: -

BERRY HILL LANE, MANSFIELD

- From a point 14 metres south-west of its junction with Jenny Becketts Lane/Black Scotch Lane in a south-westerly direction for 9.2 metres.

The crossing is being installed to improve pedestrian safety, especially for school children on their way to and from Berry Hill Primary School.
