BIRDCROFT LANE, WALKERINGHAM – PROPOSED ONE WAY STREET AND NO ENTRY PROHIBITION OFF BECKINGHAM ROAD PUBLIC CONSULTATION – TRO 1245

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce a prohibition of entry from Beckingham Road into Birdcroft Lane in Walkeringham. The prohibition is being introduced to stop right turning vehicles from waiting on Beckingham Road before turning into Birdcroft Lane as waiting vehicles are not easily seen by approaching traffic. The visibility of the turning vehicles is restricted by the bends to the north and south of the junction. It is anticipated that the number of vehicles wanting to turn will increase due to the construction of additional residential properties on Birdcroft Lane. In addition to the no entry it is proposed to make the east to west section of Birdcroft Lane a one way street from the corner towards Beckingham Road.

The restriction would be signed with new no entry signs at the junction of Birdcroft Lane and Beckingham Road and a one way sign on the corner of Birdcroft Lane.

Before proceeding further with the proposed one way and no entry restriction, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
