

**The Nottinghamshire County Council (Black Scotch Lane, Mansfield)  
(Prohibition of Waiting and No Stopping on Entrance Clearways) Traffic  
Regulation Order 2019 (2224)**

**AND PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Mansfield in the District of Mansfield:-

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from stopping on school entrance markings Monday to Friday, 8am-9.30am and 3pm-4.30pm along the following:-

**BLACK SCOTCH LANE, MANSFIELD (the west side)**

- from a point 85 metres south of its junction with Berry Hill Lane in a southerly direction for 69 metres

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting Monday to Friday, 8am-9.30am and 3pm-4.30pm along the following:-

**BLACK SCOTCH LANE, MANSFIELD (the west side)**

- from a point 60 metres south of its junction with Berry Hill Lane in a southerly direction for 25 metres

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Zebra crossing) and Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a humped zebra pedestrian crossing across Black Scotch Lane in the District of Mansfield approximately 30 metres south of its junction with Woodland Drive.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

**BLACK SCOTCH LANE (east side)**

- from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Woodland Drive in a southerly direction for 41 metres

**BLACK SCOTCH LANE (west side)**

- from a point opposite a point 12 metres south of its junction with Woodland Drive in a southerly direction for 54 metres

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children, in crossing the road. The raised crossing plateau (10 metres wide) is intended to slow vehicles down on the approach to the crossing. In addition, the scheme includes the alteration of the School Keep Clear markings and waiting restrictions (single yellow line) to suit the new highway layout.
