



PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING ON BROOMHILL ROAD, HUCKNALL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra crossing across Broomhill Road, in the District of Ashfield approximately 77 metres south-west of the junction with Nottingham Road (as measured along the centre line).

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking, stopping and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled areas are:-

BROOMHILL ROAD, HUCKNALL (the north-west side)

- From a point 51 metres south-west of its junction with Nottingham Road (as measured along the centre line) in a south-westerly direction for 35 metres

BROOMHILL ROAD, HUCKNALL (the south-east side)

- From a point 51 metres south-west of its junction with Nottingham Road (as measured along the centre line) in a south-westerly direction for 44 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians in crossing the road, especially school children. The new zig-zag lines on the south-east side of the road would replace the existing school keep clear marking, which prohibits stopping on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm.
