**BROOMHILL ROAD, HUCKNALL – PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING
PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

Via East Midlands is working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council to deliver highway services.

Nottinghamshire County Council have received requests to install a zebra crossing on Broomhill Road outside the Butlers Hill School and Nursery. It is therefore proposed to install a zebra crossing at the location shown on the enclosed plan. The zebra crossing would include lengths of zig-zag lines where parking, stopping and loading would be prohibited at all times. The zig-zag lines, outside the school, would replace the existing school keep clear markings which currently prohibit stopping on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm. The zebra crossing would make it safer for pedestrians to cross the road, especially children attending the school.

The extents of the proposal are shown on the enclosed drawing (H/JAB/4236/01) and notice.

Before proceeding further, I wish to consider the views of residents, businesses and organisations who may be interested in this matter. Any observations on these proposals should reach me in writing, either by letter or email, by **27th March 2023**. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals please clearly state this and the reasons for your objection. If the objection cannot be resolved, it will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time.
