BURTON ROAD, GEDLING – INTRODUCTION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING, NO WAITING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTIONS (DOUBLE YELLOW LINES) AND BUS STOP CLEARWAYS (NO STOPPING AT ANY TIME) – PUBLIC CONSULTATION – TRO 7247

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, as part of the works to build a new entrance into the Carlton le Willows Academy, is proposing to introduce a humped zebra crossing to the north-east of the junction with Beaumaris Drive. The proposed crossing is to enable pedestrians, especially school children, a safer point to cross the road. The crossing will consist of a controlled zone (length of zig-zag lines) where waiting, stopping and loading will be prohibited at all times. The controlled zone will help ensure that the zebra crossing is kept clear so that approaching vehicles can clearly see pedestrians waiting to use the crossing. The crossing will be built on a raised plateau which will be 11 metres wide (from bottom of ramp to bottom of ramp) and 75mm high.

In addition to the zebra crossing it is proposed to introduce double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) restrictions to the new academy entrance, the junction of Beaumaris Drive and to both sides of Burton Road. The double yellow lines will help keep the junctions clear of parked vehicles to allow an unobstructed crossing point for pedestrians. At the existing bus stop (ref GE0787) it is proposed to introduce a bus stop clearway (19m long) which will prohibit stopping by all vehicles, except buses. The clearway is to ensure that the bus can always stop against the kerb line to drop off and pick up passengers.

Details of the proposals ore shown on enclosed drawing H/JAB/3993/01 and notices.

Before proceeding further with the proposed restrictions, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by **29**th **July 2022**. If you are intending to submit an objection then could you please clearly state to which part of the proposal you are objecting i.e. double yellow lines, zig-zag lines, bus stop clearway or the raised plateau.
