

PROVISION OF ROAD HUMP AT EXISTING ZEBRA CROSSING

CALVERTON ROAD, ARNOLD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to install a traffic calming hump at the existing zebra crossing across Calverton Road, Arnold in the Borough of Gedling approximately 84 metres north-east of its junction with Rannoch Rise.

The hump is being installed to help reduce the speed of traffic approaching the zebra crossing and this will make the zebra crossing safer for pedestrians, especially school children, to cross the road. In addition to the construction of the hump there will be changes to the existing warning signs and the lining at the zebra crossing.

Any comments/objections (quoting ref: Calverton Rd humped zebra) in respect of the traffic calming proposal must be received by me, in writing, by **2nd August 2021**.
