

The Nottinghamshire County Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CARNARVON ROAD AND EXCHANGE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER) 2020 (8299)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on

CARNARVON ROAD AND EXCHANGE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

Carnarvon Road

from its junction with Exchange Road in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Stanley Road.

Exchange Road

from its junction with Manvers Road in a south-easterly direction to its south-eastern extremity.

 Any previous Speed Limit Order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act in so far as it related to the lengths of road specified in Schedule to this Order is hereby revoked.
