

<u>The Nottinghamshire County Council (Central Avenue, Derbyshire Lane</u> and Yorke Street, Hucknall)(Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2020 (4267)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be to roads in Hucknall in the District of Ashfield:-

Proposed No waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following location:-

1. <u>CENTRAL AVENUE (the east side)</u>

from a point 10 metres south of its junction with Derbyshire Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.

2. <u>DERBYSHIRE LANE (the south side)</u>

from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Central Avenue in an easterly direction for a distance of 3 metres.

3. <u>YORKE STREET (the east side)</u>

from its junction with Derbyshire Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The proposed restrictions are being introduced to reflect the changes as a result of the construction of the kerb build outs at the junction of Derbyshire Lane/Central Avenue/Yorke Street. The restrictions on Central Avenue are to help improve visibility for vehicles turning out of Derbyshire Lane. The proposals on Derbyshire Lane are to ensure that no vehicles park in front of the proposed bus stop clearway.

Written objections (stating grounds & quoting ref. 4267) must be received by me by the **16**th **November 2020**.
