

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCH HILL, LOW PASTURE LANE,
LOW STREET AND STURTON ROAD, NORTH WHEATLEY)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020 (1249)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be in respect of roads in Retford in the District of Bassetlaw: -

1. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time along: -

CHURCH HILL (east side)

- From its junction with Low Pasture Lane in a northerly direction for 6 metres.

CHURCH HILL (west side)

- From its junction with Low street in a northerly direction for 12 metres.

LOW STREET (north side)

- From its junction with Church Hill in a westerly direction for 18 metres.

LOW STREET (south side)

- From its junction with Sturton Road in a westerly direction for 15 metres.

LOW PASTURE LANE (north side)

- From its junction with Church Hill in an easterly direction for 10 metres.

LOW PASTURE LANE (south side)

- From its junction with Sturton Road in an easterly direction for 10 metres

STURTON ROAD (east side)

- From its junction with Low Pasture Lane in a southerly direction for 29 metres
- From a point 66 metres south of its junction with Low Pasture Lane in a southerly direction and then an easterly direction for 130 metres.

STURTON ROAD (west side)

- From its junction with Low Street in a southerly direction for 18 metres
- From a point 43 metres north west of its junction with Muspitt Lane in a southerly then easterly direction to a point 27 metres east of that of that junction.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
