**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCH STREET AND SWINECOTE  
ROAD, EDWINSTOWE) (30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017 (3263)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:-

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the following roads in Edwinstowe in the District of Newark and Sherwood,

**CHURCH STREET**

from a point 42 metres north of its junction with Maythorn Grove in a northerly direction to its junction with Swinecote Road.

**SWINECOTE ROAD**

from its junction with Church Street in a northerly direction to a point 98 metres north of the junction with Maythorn Grove.

The 30mph speed limit is being introduced as an extension to the existing 30mph speed limit on Church Street/Swinecote Road. The speed limit is being extended as a result of the new zebra crossing and road layout being built as part of the new Sherwood Forest Visitors Centre and car park.
