

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CROPWELL ROAD AND GLEBE LANE,
RADCLIFFE ON TRENT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND NO STOPPING ON ENTRANCE
CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020 (8284)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at Radcliffe on Trent in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1) Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting at any time** along the following: -

CROPWELL ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (the north-west side)

- from a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Glebe Lane in a north-westerly direction to a point 10 metres north-west of that junction.
- from a point 50 metres north-west of its junction with Glebe Lane in a north-westerly direction for 27 metres.

GLEBE LANE, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (both sides)

- from its junction with Cropwell Road in a north easterly direction for 20 metres.

VICTORIA STREET, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (both sides)

- from its junction with Cropwell Road in a north easterly direction for 11 metres.

2) Vehicles will be prohibited from **waiting on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm** along the following:

CROPWELL ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (the north-west side)

- from a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Glebe Lane in a north-easterly direction for 18 metres.
- from a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Glebe Lane in a north-westerly direction for 42 metres.

3) Vehicles will be prohibited from **stopping on school entrance markings on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm** along the following: -

CROPWELL ROAD, RADCLIFFE ON TRENT (the south-west side)

- from a point 10 metres south-east of its junction with Glebe Lane in a north-westerly direction for 26 metres.

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such as County Hall libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.
