PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Zebra crossing) and Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a humped zebra pedestrian crossing across Cross Street in the Borough of Gedling approximately 14 metres north-east of its junction with Galway Road

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

<u>Cross Street – north-west side</u>

from a point 43 metres north-east of its junction with Galway Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 56 metres.

Cross Street – south-east side

from a point 44 metres north-east of a point opposite the north-eastern kerb line of Galway Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 56 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children, in crossing the road. In addition the scheme includes no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) and no stopping restrictions (bus stop clearways). The raised crossing plateau (10 metres wide) is in keeping with other crossings on Cross Street.

Any comments/objections (quoting ref: Cross Street) in respect of the zebra crossing or the traffic calming proposal must be received by me, in writing, by **3rd June 2019**.
