

**PUBLIC TRANSPORT IMPROVEMENTS - DENNIS AVENUE BEESTON
(BUS STOP REFS: BR0302, BR0303, BR0304, BR0437, BR0438, BR0466)**

Concerns have been raised about the operating times of the existing 24-hour Bus Stop Clearways which are deemed too excessive given the current bus service operational hours.

To help alleviate this problem, it is proposed to reduce the times of the existing Bus Stop Clearways at the locations listed below from a 24-hour restriction to **Monday to Saturday 9am – 4pm**, which reflects the hours of operation of the bus service.

The clearways will prohibit all vehicles except buses from parking or waiting from Mon – Sat 9am-4pm at the bus stop and will be clearly identified with new signage. This action will ensure the bus stops will be accessible for buses serving these stops during these times.

Proposed works will, in summary, consist of:– **Removal of old signage and erection of new signage and a repaint of the Bus Stop Clearway markings at the following Bus Stops**

**Bus Stop ref BR0302 – Dennis Avenue, Beeston
Bus Stop ref BR0303 – Dennis Avenue, Beeston
Bus Stop ref BR0304 – Dennis Avenue, Beeston
Bus Stop ref BR0437 – Dennis Avenue, Beeston
Bus Stop ref BR0438 – Dennis Avenue, Beeston
Bus Stop ref BR0466 – Brook Road, Beeston**
