

PUBLIC TRANSPORT IMPROVEMENTS EAKRING ROAD, MANSFIELD

(Reference: MA0012 - Eakring Road, Mansfield)

As part of Nottinghamshire County Council's on-going commitment to improve public transport in the County, Nottinghamshire County Council Transport Facilities are making it easier for buses to stop in Mansfield and are proposing that bus stop MA0012 is relocated approximately 32 metres east of its current location with an enforceable 19 metre bus stop clearway.


The clearway will prohibit all vehicles except buses from parking or stopping **At Any Time** at this location and this will be clearly identified with new signage. As a result, the proposed new bus stop will be accessible for buses serving that stop during these times.

The proposal will in summary, consist of:

MA0012 - Eakring Road - Bus Stop shelter & pole relocation approximately 32 metres east.

Enforceable 19 Metre Bus Stop Clearway (No Stopping at Any Time, Except Buses)
