NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effects of which will be to Butt Lane, By-Way No 44, East Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

1. To prohibit motor vehicles from driving on

Butt Lane, By-Way No 44, East Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe

From its junction with Butt Lane in a northerly then easterly direction for 220 metres

In order to prevent unauthorised use of East Bridgford Restricted Byway No. 44 (Butt Lane). Nottinghamshire County Council is proposing to introduce a Prohibition of Driving and close the byway to motorised vehicles. The route will remain open to legal users; walkers, horse riders, pedal-cyclists and horse drawn vehicles.
