EVANS ROAD AND SHEEPWASH WAY, EAST LEAKE – PROPOSED DOUBLE YELLOW LINES (NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) AND SCHOOL KEEP CLEARS (NO STOPPING – MON TO FRI BETWEEN 8AM & 4.30PM) – PUBLIC CONSULTATION – TRO 8375

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) and No Stopping on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm restrictions (School Keep Clear markings) in the vicinity of the new Millside Spencer Academy on Evans Road in East Leake. At the turning head on Sheepwash Way it is proposed to remove the existing School Keep Clear markings and replace them with no waiting at any time restrictions.

The proposals on Evans Road are intended to keep the area around the new academy entrance free of parked/stopped vehicles during the school day. This will help to make the area safer for students attending the new academy. The existing school keep clear restrictions on Sheepwash Way will not be required once the new academy opens. The proposed replacement no waiting at any time restrictions will help ensure that the turning head is kept clear of parked vehicles to allow other vehicles to turn around.

The locations of the proposed restrictions are shown on the attached plans and notice.

Before proceeding further with the proposed parking and stopping restrictions, I wish to consider the views of residents and organisations who may be interested in this matter. If your comments are in the form of an objection to the proposals and if they cannot be resolved, they will be reported through the County Council's procedures at the appropriate time. Any observations on these proposals should reach me by 8th November 2023.
