

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (EVANS ROAD AND SHEEPWASH WAY, EAST LEAKE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND ENTRANCE CLEARWAYS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023 (8375)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (County of Nottinghamshire) Designation Order 2008 (SI 2008 No. 1086), as amended, the effects of which will be, in respects of roads at East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

1. <u>Proposed prohibition of Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) along the following lengths of road: -</u>

EVANS ROAD (The east side)

- (i) From a point 29 metres north of point opposite the northern kerb line of its junction with Anning Crescent in a northerly direction for 7 metres.
 EVANS ROAD (The south side)
- (ii) From a point 87 metres north and then west of its junction with Anning Crescent in a westerly direction for 27 metres.
- (iii) EVANS ROAD (The west side)
 (iii) From a point 33 metres north of its junction with Anning Crescent in a northerly and then a westerly direction for 34 metres.
 SHEEPWASH WAY (The south-east side)
- (iv) from a point 2 metres north-west of its south-eastern extremity in a south-easterly direction to a point 2 metres north-west of its eastern extremity
- 2. <u>Proposed No Stopping on Entrance Clearways on Monday to Friday between 8am and 4.30pm.</u> <u>EVANS ROAD (The east side)</u>
- (i) From a point 36 metres north of point opposite the northern kerb line of its junction with Anning Crescent in a northerly and then a westerly direction for 38 metres.
 <u>EVANS ROAD (The north side)</u>
- (ii) From a point 94 metres north and then west of point opposite the northern kerb line of its junction with Anning Crescent in a westerly direction for 25 metres.
