ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Flatts Lane, Calverton in the Borough of Gedling approximately 62 metres north of its junction with Collyer Road.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are: -

Flatts Lane – west side

from a point 42 metres north of its junction with Collyer Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 44 metres.

Flatts Lane – east side

from a point 55 metres north of its junction with Collyer Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 36 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians, especially school children, in crossing Flatts Lane.
