

## THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (GARTH ROAD & WAVERLEY ROAD, MANSFIELD) TRAFFIC CALMING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of powers conferred by Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 propose to "Traffic Calm" Garth Road and Waverley Road, Mansfield.

The effects of which will be to: -

Install 4 No. sets of sinusoidal humps on Garth Rd and Waverley Rd, Mansfield; with 2 humps on Garth Rd and 2 humps on Waverley Rd. These are 75mm high and 4m long in the direction of travel.

The proposed traffic calming features is intended to reduce the number of road accidents by slowing down the vehicles entering the residential area from the main road.
