

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL GEDLING VILLAGE AREA (WEIGHT RESTRICTION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020 (7224)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make an Order under Sections 1 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The effect of the Order will be, in respect of roads at Carlton, Gedling and Mapperley in the Borough of Gedling, no heavy commercial vehicle shall proceed in any of the following roads or lengths of road within the boundary described below:-

South-western side of the **Gedling Access Road**, outer perimeter of the roundabout junction with the Gedling Access Road and **Arnold Lane**, south-western side of **Arnold Lane**, south-western side of **Main Road**, western side of **Shearing Hill**, north-western side of **Burton Road**, south-eastern side of Burton Road, eastern side of the **Colwick Loop Road**, Nottingham to Newark **railway line**, south-western and north-eastern sides of **Stoke Lane**, Nottingham to Newark railway line, western Highway boundary of **Trent Valley Road** (A612).

As a result of the impact of COVID-19 and in accordance with Public Health England's advice on social distancing and avoiding non-essential trips, public buildings such at County Hall and libraries are closed or if reopened will have restrictions in place.

The Order is intended to preserve or improve the amenities of the area by prohibiting or restricting the use on roads in the area by heavy goods vehicles. The weight limit is being introduced as part of the measures associated with the new Gedling Access Road.
