

PROVISION OF PUFFIN AND TOUCAN PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a puffin pedestrian crossing and a Toucan cycle/pedestrian crossing across the Gedling Access Road in the Borough of Gedling.

The centre of the **Puffin Crossing** will be approximately 314 metres south-east of its junction with Lambley Lane.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

Gedling Access Road – north-east side

from a point 293 metres south-east of the centre line of its junction with Lambley Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 48 metres

Gedling Access Road – south-west side

from a point 291 metres south-east of a point opposite the centre line of its junction with Lambley Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 48 metres.

The crossing is being installed to assist pedestrians in crossing the Gedling Access Road. The crossing is on the new alignment of the Carlton footpath No.2.

The centre of the **Toucan Crossing**, on the north-east side of the road, is approximately 17 metres south-east of the outer perimeter of the roundabout with the Gedling Access Road and Waldrom Road. The centre of the crossing on the south-west side of the road is approximately 21 metres south-east of the outer perimeter of the roundabout.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

Gedling Access Road – north-east side

from a point 3 metres south-east of the outer perimeter of the roundabout of the Gedling Access Road and Waldrom Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 31 metres (as measured along the centre line)

Gedling Access Road – south-west side

from the outer perimeter of the roundabout of the Gedling Access Road and Waldrom Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 42 metres (as measured along the centre line)
