

GERTRUDE ROAD AND RUTLAND ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD
PROPOSED RAISED PLATEAU TRAFFIC CALMING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install one raised traffic calming plateau on Gertrude Road, West Bridgford and one raised traffic calming plateau on Rutland Road, West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe: -

The extents of the plateaus are detailed below:

GERTRUDE ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

- From its junction with Rutland Road, in a northerly direction for 10.5 metres.

RUTLAND ROAD, WEST BRIDGFORD

- From a point 6 metres north-west of its junction with Gertrude Road, in a south-easterly direction for 20.5 metres.

The County Council has been allocated £3.25m through the Transforming Cities Fund (TCF) to improve strategic connection to and from the new bridge crossing and as a result is seeking to increase traffic safety at the junctions of Rutland Road and Gertrude Road, West Bridgford.
