



NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

PROVISION OF HUMPED ZEBRA CROSSING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90A - 90I of the Highways Act 1980 (traffic calming hump), proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Gotham Road, East Leake in the Borough of Rushcliffe on an existing road hump approximately 52 meters north of its junction with Main Street.

The crossing will incorporate a controlled area indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are: -

Gotham Road – west side

from a point 34 metres north of its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 31m metres.

Gotham Road – east side

from a point 37 metres north of its junction with Main Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 37 metres.

The crossing is being installed on an existing road hump to assist pedestrians in crossing Gotham Road. In addition, the scheme includes no stopping restrictions (relocation of bus stop and clearway ref RU0408 to approx.6m south).
