<u>PROPOSED ZEBRA CROSSING ON GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD - PUBLIC NOTIFICATION</u>

Via East Midlands Ltd, working on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council, is proposing to install a zebra crossing on the existing raised ramped plateau on Greythorn Drive, West Bridgford, approximately 18 metres south of Walcote Drive. The proposed zebra crossing will consist of a controlled zone (length of white zig-zag lines) where waiting and loading will be prohibited at all times.
