

## **PROVISION OF ZEBRA CROSSING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Nottinghamshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to install a zebra pedestrian crossing across Greythorn Drive, West Bridgford in the Borough of Rushcliffe approximately 18 metres south of its junction with Walcote Drive

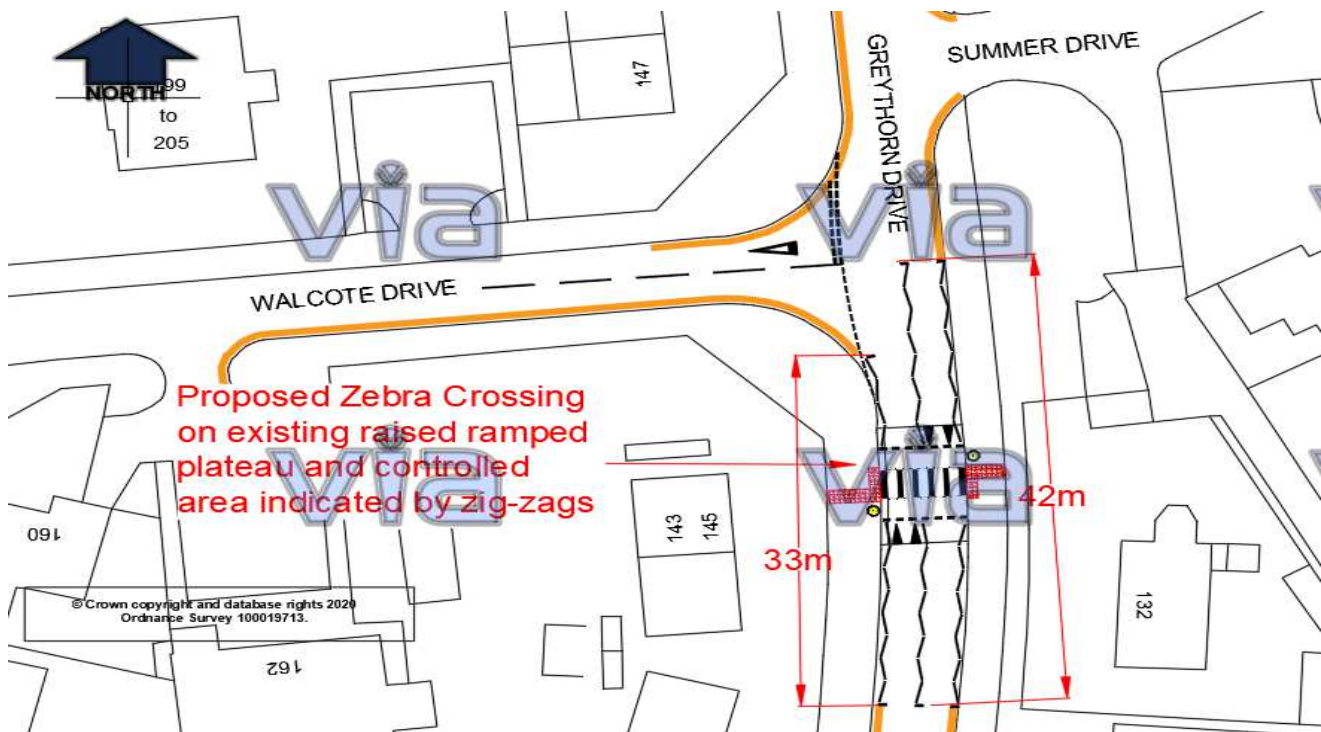
The crossing will incorporate a controlled area, on the existing raised plateau, indicated by zig-zag markings along the carriageway where parking and loading will be prohibited. The extents of the controlled area are:-

### **GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the east side)**

- from its junction with Walcote Drive in a southerly direction for 42 metres

### **GREYTHORN DRIVE, WEST BRIDGFORD (the west side)**

- from its junction with Walcote Drive in a southerly direction for 33 metres
